Grow Deep

Dear friends in Christ

The very last words of Jesus before he ascended into heaven aptly summarize the mission of every Christian to: "Go, therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit..." (Mt. 28:19-20). During this final audience with his apostles and followers Jesus could not be clearer of his vision for every one of his disciples. Now more than ever he needs all of us to respond to this invitation to be his disciples and make disciples of others.

As a community of faith, we have challenged ourselves to become **intentional disciples**. To be an intentional disciple basically means to enter into a personal relationship with Jesus by purposefully wanting to know him more, love him more and serve him more. It is about our genuine desire and courage to **grow deeper** in this relationship of love with the one who truly loves us. Jesus came in person because he wants to establish personal relationships with each one of us. As Catholic Christians it is just not enough to attend services on a regular basis and experience no personal connections with the community, much less no personal relationship with the one we worship, Jesus Christ. But as we desire and hopefully be gifted with a personal relationship, knowledge and love of Jesus, we truly become his intentional disciples.

Reach Wide is the second core value we truly believe and invested in as a parish. This value is the natural fruit of our first core value, **Grow Deep**. Without the gift of a personal relationship with Jesus there's no way we can reach out to make disciples of others. This Sunday's gospel captures this vision of Jesus to **Reach Wide** by sending out 70 of his disciples in pairs "to every town and place where he himself intended to go" (Lk 10:1). After the miraculous feeding of five thousand people and other miracles, his personal dialogue with the apostles and his transfiguration (Lk. 9), the apostles have finally come to realize who Jesus truly is, albeit imperfectly.



MASS

Set aside time for prayer and reflection, daily (ex: Grace before meals, examination of conscience, Rosary)

3

SPIRITUAL GROWTH

Participate in at least one spiritual activity in this upcoming year. (ex: Faith Study, Bible Study, Small Group)

4

HOLY REST

Enter into God's holy presence by attending a Reconciliation Liturgy, Retreat, Eucharistic Adoration, or Mission in the next year.

5

GOD MOMENTS

Look for God in everyday life and share these moments with others monthly or more often.


Sewing Help Needed


Spiritual Communion
